## 1. Rationale

Our SunSmart policy has been developed to ensure that all children attending this school are protected from skin damage caused by the harmful ultra-violet rays of the sun. It is to be implemented through the year, but with particular emphasis in Terms 1 and 4.

## 2. Aims

- 2.1 To create an awareness and understanding within the school community, of the potential damage that can be caused by the sun.
- 2.2 To encourage staff and parents to be good role models for SunSmart behaviour.
- 2.3 To teach children to accept responsibility for their own SunSmart behaviour, eg, appropriate play areas and clothing.

## 3. Implementation

- 3.1 Incorporate programs on skin cancer prevention into the curriculum.
- 3.2 Regularly reinforce SunSmart behaviour in a positive way through newsletters, information booklets, parent meetings, student and teacher activities.
- 3.3 All staff to wear appropriate clothing and hat when outdoors.
- 3.4 School hats must be worn by all children when outside during Term 1 and 4 and on other days as deemed necessary. (Hats must protect neck, ears and face, eg., slouch or legionnaire). Children without hats to play in areas protected from the sun.
- 3.5 It is the parents responsibility to provide their children with a suitable sunscreen where necessary and teach them how to apply it.
- 3.6 Teachers will remind children to apply sunscreen.
- 3.7 The SunSmart slogan will be displayed in all classrooms.
- 3.8 The school community should work towards providing adequate shade in the school grounds.

## 4. Evaluation

Evaluation will be formally undertaken during the annual policy evaluation process, during which the successes and concerns of the program will be discussed.
